

Liquid Nicotine
is TOXIC to
children.



Bottles are sold in many sizes, and in
different strengths of nicotine.



As little as one teaspoon can be fatal
to a one year old child, no matter how
they have contact (mouth or skin)



Mouth: If a child puts a vape or
bottle/canister in their mouth,
nicotine can be absorbed through
mucous membranes just like nicotine
gum.



Swallowing: If a child swallows liquid
nicotine, it will be absorbed by the
intestinal tract.

DANGER

Skin: If a child spills liquid
nicotine on their skin, it will be
absorbed just like a nicotine
patch.
